

Heritage

North of Boughton Place is Cock's Heath where it is thought the name of the Cock Inn originates. The pub itself was built in 1568 by the dioceses of Canterbury to provide lodgings for people travelling on their way to London.

In 1777 a major historical event took place in Boughton Monchelsea following the trouble between Great Britain and their colonialists and the threat of war with France loomed large. Around 15,000 troops were ordered to the village and the area became a camp and training ground for the British soldiers - the following year King George III arrived to inspect his troops.
